ORDINANCE NO. 14-1703

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CITY PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Healthy has in its possession certain property, namely, a used 1924 REO Speedwagon fire engine, hereafter referred to as the "engine" is no longer in use; and

WHEREAS, the proposed sale of the city property has been approved by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the city to sell the city property at the best price obtainable; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO

Section 1. That the sale of the surplus property "as is," referred to above is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That the buyer must make engine available for any City of Mt. Healthy event.

Section 3. That the buyer must make the engine in good running and operating condition by March 1, 2017, and make it available for the City's 200th birthday celebration.

Section 4. That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to offer for sale to the highest and best bidder; and comply with the statutory requirement for at least two weeks advertisement by publication in a newspaper of general circulation, as set out in § 721.15 of the O.R.C., and provided further that the cost of such service shall not exceed \$100 plus publication costs.

Section 5. The City of Mt. Healthy reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 6. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is the necessity for the buyer to have sufficient time to restore the engine in time for the City's 200th birthday celebration and obtaining the best price for said property before the value is further reduced by depreciation.
