The City of Mt. Healthy is happy to provide a low-cost method of refuse disposal as a service to its citizens. However, because of changes in federal regulations and dump site rules, the City has imposed the following requirements on use of city dump trucks.

1. YOU MAY NOT PUT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO A CITY DUMP TRUCK:

- Any appliance containing Freon. This would include refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc...
- Rubber tire of any kind (car, truck, heavy equipment, lawnmower, etc...)
- Lead acid batteries
- Petroleum-based materials (oil, gas, varnish, thinners, etc...)
- Toxic materials (lead based paints, paint chips, asbestos, poisons, etc...)

2. YARD WASTE

You may place yard waste in a City dump truck for disposal, provided that you do not include any other matter in the same truck. Yard waste must be kept segregated from other trash and refuse. Yard waste includes grass clippings, tree branches, shrubs, shrubbery trimmings, Christmas trees, leaves, etc. All leaves must be placed in brown paper bags for disposal (no plastic bags).

3. ALL OTHER TRASH AND REFUSE

All other trash and refuse may be placed in a City dump truck for disposal, provided that NO YARD WASTE is placed in the same truck. Permitted trash includes garbage, building scraps, appliances without freon (must have certificate stating freon removed by certified professional) carpet, etc... A good rule of thumb is that it includes everything (except yard waste) that can be thrown away at the curb.

4. The truck will be delivered around 8am and will be picked up at 3pm. The City of Mt. Healthy reserves the right to refuse any loaded truck that does not abide by the regulations listed above. The City of Mt. Healthy also reserves the right to cancel any scheduled truck rental at anytime.

The cost for the use of a City dump truck for (1) one day is \$125.00 dollars (paid upon delivery of the truck). Your use of a City dump truck is conditioned upon your acceptance of the foregoing regulations. If they are not followed, the unacceptable refuse in the truck will be returned to the renter who will be responsible for any adjustments to the load of refuse.
